



THE HILLS GROUP TO CELEBRATE 110 YEARS IN BUSINESS

In 2010 the Hills Group celebrates its 110th anniversary of being in business.

Established in 1900 by Edward Hill, the Hills Group remains a family-owned operation four generations later. Initially started as a brick making company based in Morris Street, Rodbourne, Swindon, the business has evolved into a multi-million pound operation with sites and offices throughout Wiltshire and most neighbouring counties. Its diverse activities include managing and recycling domestic and commercial waste, producing and supplying quarry products and ready-mixed concrete, and building quality homes.

As part of the celebrations Hills' staff were invited to enter a competition to design a logo to mark the mile stone. Liz Linney, receptionist at the Group's Marlborough offices, won the competition receiving a cash prize of £110 and the opportunity to donate a further £110 to the charity of her choice.
