**Low Lane, Lower Compton : Bund construction earthworks contract**

At the Liaison Committee meeting held on 5 March 2009, Hills advised that the contract for the earthworks on the site was to be put out to tender (minute item 5).

The contract has been awarded to Jones Brothers and we are writing to advise that site earthworks will commence on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2009. The expected completion date is 20<sup>th</sup> July 2009 (ie 10 weeks).

The purpose of the earthworks is to construct the new perimeter bund along the eastern and northern boundaries of the Low Lane development.

Topsoil will be stripped from Phase 1 (closest to the road), overburden dug and used to create the bund as per the planning permission. Soils will be replaced to the outer face of the bund with excess being stockpiled on site for future restoration of the landfill.

**Access:** Will be via the Lower Compton landfill site and Old Camp Farm area with no plant or vehicles using the road to the east that leads to Compton Bassett village.

**Dust suppression:** Dust will be controlled with a tractor drawn water bowser to keep haul roads damp.

**Footpath:** The recently redirected public footpath will remain open during the construction of the bund as it lies outside the works area.
