Calling junior golf enthusiasts

Budding young golfers in Wiltshire have just over a week left to enter the 31st Hills Wiltshire Junior Golf Championships being held at North Wilts Golf Club on Monday 24 October.

The competition is open to boys and girls, with those over 10 years of age playing the full 18-hole course in a medal format, and those aged 10 and under playing a shorter 10 hole course on a stableford format with a two shot allowance per hole. Entry fees, which include a meal, are £10.00 per player.

Prizes will be awarded for each age group starting at 6 years of age and these include vouchers for both gross and net scores for entrants in the 18 hole medal. Overall boys' and girls' gross score winners will receive trophies together with a trophy for best net overall.
