SITE OPERATIONS

Responding to a query from Cllr Boyd, Ed Dodd confirmed that whilst Hills' lease on the site ends in 2016 the company would remain responsible for the restored areas for the next 60 years. Ed Dodd also confirmed that Hills would tender for ongoing work when Swindon Borough Council puts out the tender contract. Cllr Boyd reported a complaint regarding a Hills truck. Ed Dodd requested that where possible registration numbers be recorded and passed onto Hills. Ed Dodd confirmed that Hills' transport operations and compliance managers would be advised. Ed Dodd reported that the Environment Agency had undertaken a gas audit of the site at the end of 2009.
