Purton Parish Council will be raising a cuppa on Thursday 17 November when they reveal the new, improved kitchen area within the Purton Village Hall.



The refurbishment project was made possible following a grant of £15,000 from Hills Waste Solutions from the Landfill Communities Fund (LCF) which is administered by Community First. Further donations were made by Wiltshire Council Area Board, Vastern Lodge, Purton in Bloom, Purton Lydiard Charity, Age Concern and other private contributors.

All the funders will join the Parish Council to celebrate the improvements that have been made to this well-used and central community amenity over the past few months.

Ed Dodd, disposal team manager for Hills Waste Solutions, says, "It is really important to have a community area like this village hall where local people can meet and hold events. Hills is pleased to have been able to help with the funding."



The old kitchen was stripped out to create a new efficient catering area including a large electric cooker and hood; microwave; water boiler; new sink and kitchen units. The entire area has also been redecorated and new serving hatch shutters installed.

"Having a well equipped and modern facility such as this will definitely help to increase the hiring income for the Hall and that money will contribute to the maintenance and upkeep of the building," says parish clerk Shirley Bevington.
