Winners announced in Hills Group CPRE Wiltshire Best Kept Village Competition 2013

Three Wiltshire villages are celebrating their success after being judged as the 'best kept' in a county wide competition this month.

Burbage, All Cannings and Teffont won the categories of large, medium and small villages respectively and competed against 47 other villages for their titles.

The annual competition, sponsored this year by The Hills Group, is run by the Campaign to Protect Rural England (CPRE) and judging criteria includes tidiness, cleanliness, presentation and village community spirit.
