

Project engineer, Civil - FTC (Calne)

Hills Waste Solutions Ltd has an exciting opportunity for a project engineer to join the team, on a fixed term contract basis, based at Lower Compton.

Reporting to the engineering manager, the successful candidate will be required to provide engineering support to the planning, organising and controlling of all projects, relating to the operation and development of waste facilities.

Working on a range of existing and forecast projects, valued between £0.5 and £5 million, they will also be responsible for ensuring all costs are controlled in line with budget targets and all works are carried out in strict compliance with the company's Health and Safety Policy and the Health and Safety at Work Act.

The successful candidate will be employed predominantly in a resident engineer capacity and visiting and monitoring the project sites, managing contractors and providing technical support will be paramount, alongside maintaining detailed project programmes incorporating timescales, responsibilities and cost appraisals.

Key responsibilities within the role include:

- To supervise contractors working on site on a daily basis reporting any technical issues, progress, delays, programme and cost implications of the works to the engineering manager
- To ensure project works are carried out to an agreed form of contract and are tendered to achieve the best value for money
- To attend regular project meetings with contractors and the relevant personnel to ensure work is carried out to the required standard, on time and on budget
- To complete a monthly project progress report and submission to the engineering manager.

Applicants will be required to have a relevant degree in civil engineering or in a related technical discipline. They will have site resident engineer experience and have worked on projects at various stages, from commencement of earthworks to completion and handover. Knowledge of AutoCAD and MS project would be advantageous.

The role requires the successful candidate to be a strong communicator, with the ability to build and maintain relationships at all levels. They will have a methodical and analytical approach and have the capacity to analyse and evaluate situations on the ground. They will also need to be willing to attend courses, integrate into the team and enjoy working outdoors. A full driving licence is essential.

The contract is offered initially on a 12 month fixed term but may be extended for a further 12 months, dependent on project scope.
