



Shift Process Operator Westbury

Hills Waste Solutions is recruiting a shift process operator, to work at the Northacre Resource Recovery Centre (NRRC) in Westbury.

Reporting to the Shift Supervisor, the principal purpose of this role is to control the operation of the mechanical and biological treatment (MBT) process from within the control room. This includes the operation of the weighbridge, receipt and dispatch of waste, and multi-role work within processing areas to ensure compliance with planning and permit conditions.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, maintaining appropriate records and logs of operational data and information, ensuring that deliveries and dispatches made from the site are processed in an efficient and meticulous manner; assist with and perform preventative maintenance, on fixed and mobile plant and support others in maintaining the site in a safe and clean condition.

It is essential that candidates have previous experience of working within a process plant environment, be computer literate and aware of current safety and environmental regulations. You will be an effective communicator and be able to take full responsibility for the efficient running of the facility in the absence of the Supervisor providing direction and supervision to staff.

Some supervisory or leadership experience, an understanding of safety and safe systems, and telehandler/fork lift truck qualifications are desirable.

The successful candidate will be required to work shifts between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00 Monday to Friday and alternate Saturday mornings.
